scientists
investigating HeLa
began using her
husband and
children in research
without informed
consent. And
though the cells
had launched a
multimillion-dollar
industry that sells
human biological
materials, her

family never saw any of the profits. We provide an in depth analysis of how you can use your marketing plan in order to drive sales. Chapter 6 - Personnel Summary - Here, we showcase the organizational structure of your business coupled with the headcount and salaries of your

employees. Chapter 7 - Financial Plan - This is the most important part of your business plan. Here, we provide a three year profit and loss statement, cash flow analysis, balance sheet, sensitivity analysis, breakeven analysis, and business ratios.
